a Republican. She's also a teacher and a
proud gun owner. But before the 2012
elections, when she ran for the

Minnesota state Senate, she spoke out against gun control laws and spoke in favor of a bill that would allow teachers to carry guns in schools. "I wanted to draw a line in the sand. That's how I feel," she told the St. Paul Pioneer Press in 2012. "I don't know where that's going to go, but we can only do what we can do." The bill passed. But in the age of the school shooting, she is now willing to speak out in favor of a different law. Huxtable has introduced a bill in the Legislature that would allow teachers to carry guns. So what changed? "As a teacher and as a gun owner, I'm a pro-gun person," Huxtable told NBC News. "But at this point, I'm

a pro-life person." The bill would allow public school teachers to keep a loaded, concealed handgun with them when they go to school. "I'm proposing to allow teachers and school staff who wish to be armed to carry firearms in schools as a security measure, just as police officers do now," Huxtable said in a statement to NBC News. Under the bill, the firearms would have to be off school grounds and would have to be stored in locked vehicles. And the teachers would have to have received some kind of training. It's not the only bill on the table right now in the Minnesota legislature. "I'm not sitting here like this is a new idea," Huxtable

said. "I think this is an idea that has been talked about and debated on and off for a long time." Still, some school board members and school employees have raised concerns about arming teachers, according to the St. Paul Pioneer Press. "As a teacher and as a gun owner, I'm a pro-gun person," she said. "But at this point, I'm a pro-life person." "It's a classic, safety measure, it's not a new idea," Huxtable said.
